



## 2019-2020 WELCOME LETTER

Welcome to our Awana Club! We are excited to have your child join us and look forward to another great year at Faith Bible Fellowship Church of Harleysville. Please review this orientation packet to learn how our club will operate. Please register your child online at [www.faithbfc.org](http://www.faithbfc.org). Please print and bring with you a completed health form on our opening night. We have planned a fun-packed, spiritually-enriching year for your child!

Our club meets every **Wednesday evening from 6:30-8:00 P.M.**, beginning in September and continuing through April. With the exception of September, on the first Wednesday of each month, because of our Wednesday Fellowship Dinner (WEHOF), club will be abbreviated and meet **7:00-8:00 P.M.** We may also hold special events throughout the year. See the Fall and Spring calendars for the complete list of club dates, times, and events.

Our clubs are broken down into the following age-specific groups:

**Awana Cubbies** – 2 year program for **Pre-K children.**

**Awana Sparks** - children in **Kindergarten through 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade.**

**Awana Truth and Training (TNT)** - children in **3<sup>rd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> grade.**

Dues are collected each Wednesday night to help defer certain club expenses. **Dues for all clubbers are \$1.00 per week**, and will be collected by your child's leader. You can also pay your dues monthly by cash or check made to Faith BFC Awana. If you prefer to pay dues for the year, the amount is \$25.

After our opening night, clubbers will begin working in their assigned handbook that contains memory verses and Bible lessons. There is a cost for each handbook. Since we are moving away from self-paced work and towards all working at the same pace in small groups, every clubber will need to purchase a new book this year. Clubbers who attend faithfully and stay on pace with their class will receive recognition for the work completed in that book. Each clubber will also need to purchase and wear an Awana uniform for their respective club. Please see the Price List for uniform, handbook, and bag prices. Your child should **wear their uniform each week**, as well as bring their **Bible, handbook, and dues**. If needed, please do not hesitate to ask about available scholarships.

Game time, a favorite part of the evening for many clubbers, is held in our gymnasium each week. Please send your children prepared to participate. All clubbers should wear sneakers and appropriate clothing; no flip-flops or open toed shoes please! **Please note, on WEHOF nights, since Awana will be abbreviated with the starting time at 7:00 P.M., there will be no gym time on those nights only.**

**We ask that you be prompt in picking up your child at the end of the night.** All children are to be picked up in their rooms as follows: Cubbies room 115, Sparks room 102, and TNT in their respective rooms. For your child's safety, children will not be allowed to wait for their parent/guardian outside of the church building. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter and for helping to make this a safe and enjoyable year. Should you have any questions, please feel free to contact us or the church office.
